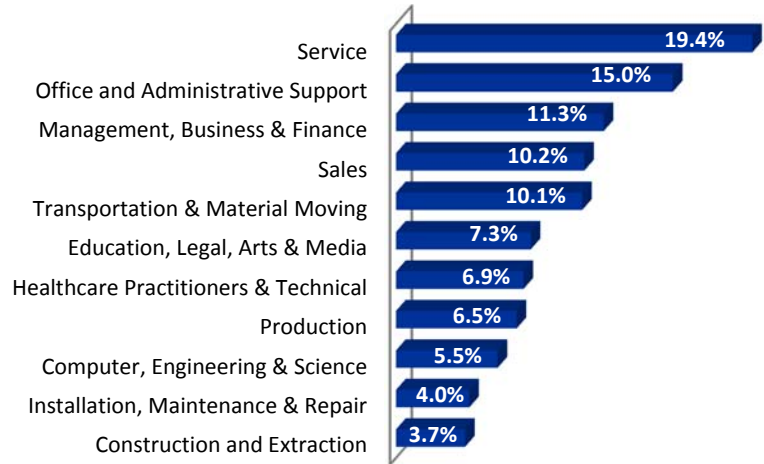




# Indianapolis Region Workforce

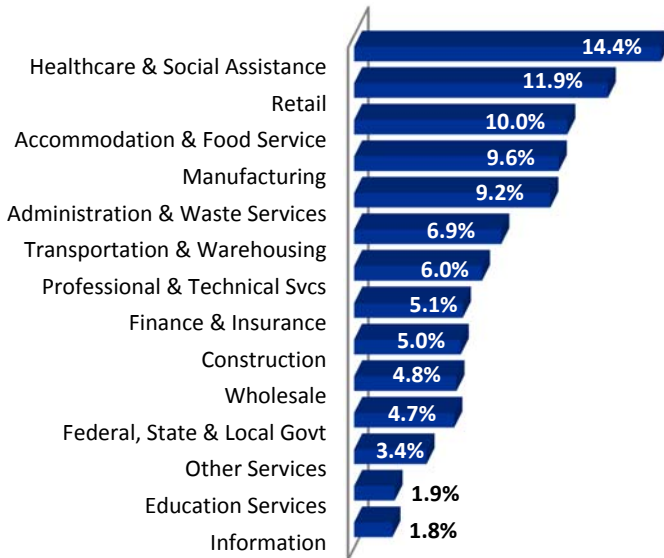
- Regional workforce of over one million
- 22 colleges & universities within 70 miles; 19 technical schools within 50 miles
- #1 business climate in the Midwest and 5<sup>th</sup> best in U.S. (*Chief Executive Magazine, 2017*)
- Indianapolis-Carmel has the second highest employment location quotient among US metro areas in pharmaceuticals & drugs (*Battelle, 2012*)
- Indianapolis metro is the only US metro area with a specialized employment concentration in all five bioscience subsectors (*Battelle, 2012*)
- 6.5% of metro Indianapolis' private employment is in foreign owned enterprises (*Brookings, 2011*)
