# Corporate Headquarters Announcements

### **Moser Consulting, Inc.**

December 2017 - Indianapolis-based Moser Consulting Inc. says it is looking to grow with the Indy technology scene. The company is planning to invest more than \$1.5 million to expand its operations in Marion County and add 116 jobs by the end of 2022.

The Indiana Economic Development Corp. offered Moser up to \$2.5 million in conditional tax credits. The city of Indianapolis supports this project.

### **KAR Auction Services, Inc.**

September 2017 - KAR Auction Services Inc. announced plans for an \$80 million corporate campus in Carmel that will allow it to add 400 jobs. KAR, a used and salvaged vehicle auction service company, employs 17,400 employees in the United States, Mexico, Canada and the United Kingdom, including 1,600 in Indiana. About 900 of those employees are based at the Carmel headquarters.

The Indiana Economic Development Corp. offered KAR up to \$6.45 million in conditional tax credits and up to \$500,000 based on the job-creation plans. The incentive plan also would provide Hamilton County with as much as \$1 million in infrastructure assistance from the state's Industrial Development Grant Fund.

### **Office 360**

July 2017 - Office360, an office solutions and products supply company, announced plans today to expand its operations, creating up to 30 new jobs by 2022. Office360 provides customized solutions designed to improve the cost effectiveness and efficiency of its clients' business operations. The company works with its customers to evaluate individual business needs and to identify cost-cutting solutions across all functional areas of the business and product categories.

The Indiana Economic Development Corporation (IEDC) offered Office360 up to \$125,000 in conditional tax credits and up to \$110,000 in training grants based on the company's job creation plans. The city of Indianapolis supports the project.

### **Fizziology**

June 2017 - Fizziology, a global audience insights firm for the entertainment, retail and travel industries, announced plans to expand its headquarters, creating up to 55 new, high-wage jobs by 2020. The company, which was just included on Inc. Magazine's 2017 Best Workplaces list, will invest \$555,030 into its operations, expanding its offices.

The Indiana Economic Development Corporation offered Fizziology up to \$588,000 in conditional tax credits and up to \$100,000 in training grants based on the company's job creation plans. The city of Indianapolis supports the project.

### **Allegion Americas**

May 2017 - Allegion PLC (NYSE: ALLE) announced plans to expand its North American headquarters in Carmel. The security products company says it will add 125 jobs as part of a \$4 million investment.

Carmel has offered to support the expansion with a 10-year property-tax abatement on the company's investment in personal property

### **Mitsch Design**

April 2017 - Mitsch Design, a commercial interior architectural design firm, announced plans to expand its headquarters in Hamilton County, nearly tripling its office space and creating up to 43 new jobs by 2021. The company will invest \$2.38 million to expand its headquarters.

The Indiana Economic Development Corporation (IEDC) offered Mitsch Design Inc. up to \$75,000 in training grants and up to \$225,000 in conditional tax credits based on the company's job creation plans. The city of Carmel supports the project.
