44.6% of the Indianapolis population and 27.0% of the metro population is of Hispanic/Latino origin or is non-white.

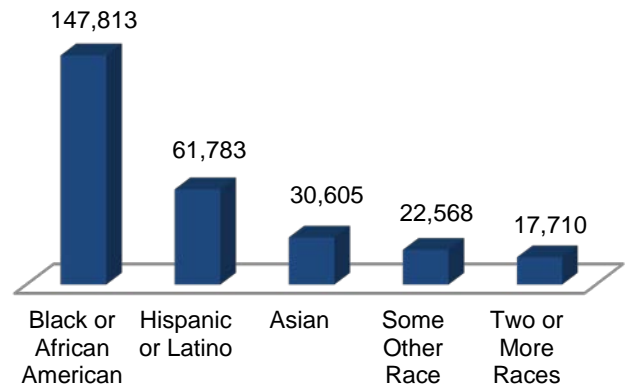
14.0% of Marion County’s population and 10.0% of the metro population speak a language other than English at home.

9.5% of Marion County’s population is foreign-born while 7.1% of the Indianapolis-Carmel-Anderson metro area is foreign-born.

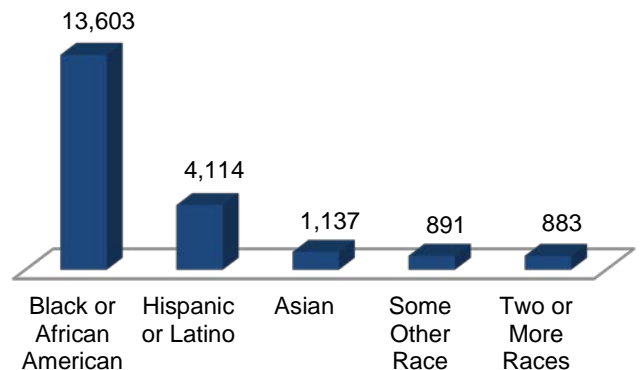
